**It was resolved to open the meeting to allow Mr Collingham to address the meeting.**

**106 Update from Dersingham Centre Association**

Mr Collingham advised that the Association has a healthy bank balance of over £5,000. They had a very successful quiz making around £500. Mr Collingham said that they were trying to put on an event each month. February was a Pancake and Beatle Drive, banners should go up tomorrow. There is a Tea Dance with the kind help of Mrs P Hunter on the 25<sup>th</sup> March. On the 21<sup>st</sup> April there is to be a Race Night being organised by Cllr Hopkins. Cllr Hopkins asked if sponsors and horses are being sold. Mr Collingham advised that he had sent an email regarding sponsorship but had been away and needed to chase up. Atelier Associates had agreed to be the main sponsor and to take a race to sell, Mr Judd and the Clerk also took a race to sell. **It was resolved for the names of sponsors to be used on race 8 if all sponsors are sourced.** Cllr Payne advised that there was to be an Easter Family Event on the 8<sup>th</sup> April between 14:30 to 16:30 where crafts etc would be available for children to undertake.
